

The following are items that Genesis considers staple goods. These are items that they expect to have on hand for those that need it each month:

Vegetables, beans, tomato sauce or tomatoes, soup, Ramen Noodles, canned fish or meat, frozen meat, Hamburger Helper/Tuna Helper, Macaroni & Cheese, pasta/noodles, spaghetti sauce, jelly, peanut butter, Jell-O or pudding, cereal, toilet paper.

The following items <u>may</u> be available: bread, cake mixes or muffin mixes, canned fruit, dry milk, popcorn, potato mixes, and rice.
